



The Art Students League of New York Grant and Scholarship List 2010

Application submission deadline for awards (except Work-Study and Jean Gates) is Friday, April 16, 2010.

Nessa Cohen Grant value: up to \$6,000 and one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to students of sculpture, drawing, printmaking and watercolor, only. No painting or pastel students. Students who have been enrolled in a painting or pastel class in the current school year (since September 2009) are not eligible.
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year and not in a painting or pastel class
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
two awards per student limit

Jean Gates Award for Work-Study Recipients (see reverse for work-study) value: up to \$3,000

- Open to Work-Study applicants working in all media
- Submit one digital image of a recent work (on standard size CD-ROM) along with completed Work-Study application by May 7, 2010
one award per student limit

Nabeela George Scholarship value: one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to physically disabled students working in all media, 18 years of age or older
- Submit one set of no more than ten images of current work in digital or slide format
two awards per student limit

Xavier Gonzalez and Ethel Edwards Travel Grant value: \$15,000

- Open to students whose focus is painting
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009) and in a painting class
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Travel/study in Spain for at least four (4) months
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

The Kuniyoshi Award value: \$5,000 and one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to students of painting
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009) and in a painting class
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

Phyllis H. Mason Grant value: \$6,000 and one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to students of traditional representational painting in oil
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009) and in a painting class
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

Edward G. McDowell Travel Grant value: \$9,000 and one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to single (unmarried) students working in any medium and style
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009)
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Travel/study in Europe for three (3) months, to include Paris
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

Merit Scholarship value: one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to students working in all media
- Candidates must have completed 210 hours in full- or part-time classes (approx. three months of full-time classes, or one year of part-time classes)
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

Lloyd Sherwood Grant value: \$6,000 and one full-time class for the regular school year

- Open to students of nonobjective / abstract art (painters working in oil, acrylic or mixed media)
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009) and in a painting or mixed media class
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Submit three pieces of artwork for juried review
one award per student limit

Vytlacil Residency Award value: award covers 2 months of residency, lunch daily and mentor

The Vytlacil Residency Award provides for 3 recipients an intensive two-month working experience on the wooded, fifteen-acre campus that was the estate of the late League instructor and artist Vaclav Vytlacil.

- Open to students working in all media
- ASL membership in good standing at the time of application
- Candidates must have completed 1120 hours in full-time classes (approx. sixteen months of full-time classes), of which 420 hours (approx. six months) must be of the current school year (since September 2009)
- All required hours must be completed by the application deadline
- Recipients / participants are required to commit to a two-month program
- Recipients / participants are required to live on Vytlacil campus
- Submit 10 slide transparencies or 10 photographs on CD with application
one award per student limit

***Work-Study** value: one full-time class

- Open to all students
- Work four hours per week at the League
- Interview required
- Two samples of artwork reviewed at interview
four awards per student limit

*Work-Study applications are accepted throughout the year. However, applications submitted by May 7, 2010 will be given priority consideration for the school year beginning in September.

New Award Limit Policy (implemented 2010)

League students may apply for as many awards as they wish but may receive only one (grant or scholarship) during any given Art Students League grant and scholarship competition week. Students who apply for more than one award and subsequently win an award are required to withdraw pending applications for all other awards. A list of grant and merit scholarship winners will be posted on the gallery doors by 6:00 p.m. each day of the competition week.
