What students must bring:

Leather shoes or boots, (no synthetics),
Tough jeans, (no synthetics, corduroy or velour),
Dust mask,
Magic marker,

What the welding shop supplies to students:

Hearing protection,
Face shields,
Welding gloves, jackets, aprons,
Welding rods, (to learn how to weld with, but if you need to use many, you must buy your own from the ASL store or from an outside source),
Masking tape, scissors, rulers, exacto blades,

Optional:

Welding cap,
Grinding and welding shields,
Leather gloves, jackets, aprons,
Grinders,
Pliers and other hand tools
Welding rods,

What can be purchased from the ASL store:

Important Notes:

- New students must start at the beginning of the month.
- Students must attend classes in the same periods they have paid for (ONLY!) and not in any other time period.

- If a student wants to attend an additional single session class, they must get instructor approval and pay for a ticket from the office.
