Payne's grey

Brushes

3 Bristle rounds, Flats & Brights ¼ inch to 2 inches
3 Synthetic – Rounds, Brights, flats ¼ inches to 3 inches wide (to cover large surfaces)
3 Synthetic rounds 0 to 000
3 Fan brushes ½ inch, 1 inch, 2 inches or wider

Palette Knife(s) Creative Mark, with 3 to 4 inch blade

Palette

Wooden At least 12 x 12 or larger, Lacquered with polyurethane
Please No white paper palettes

- Liquin to make paint dry faster or Chelsea Classical pale linseed oil

- Gamsol
- Bounty brand paper towels and/or Cotton Rags
- Panel or Canvas
- Nitrile Gloves or similar

Drawing materials

10 x 12 sketchpad or larger, white, beige or mid grey

Charcoal pencils HB, 2B, 8B

White pastel pencil if working on toned surface (the softer the better)

Graphite pencils HB, 2B, 8B

Knife or pencil sharpener

Staedtler Eraser or Staedtler Mars plastic eraser which can be shaped with a knife

Or you may use Micronpens, ballpoint pens, watercolor and pastels too.

Miscellaneous but necessary

- Gray Scale/Value Chart from <http://www.pictureperfectviewfinder.com/>
- Knitting needle for measuring
- Westcott 18-inch Ruler (transparent ruler in inches)
- Easel or surface to work on
- Extra light if you need it: Spot light **Daylight Uno Lamp with Clamp**, or any daylight **OttLite Lamp**.
