This position will handle maintenance, basic repairs, and environmental engineering services. Moderate skills and knowledge are required in electrical, plumbing, HVAC, carpentry, and mechanical equipment.

Responsibilities will range from general maintenance repairs, changing door locks, light bulb replacement, and patching drywall, to painting, sweeping and mopping as needed, and loading /unloading delivery materials and equipment inside and outside the facility.

To be considered for this position you should be an energetic self-starter with a positive attitude, be a quick learner who pays attention to details, and be able to work under pressure and on their own.
