

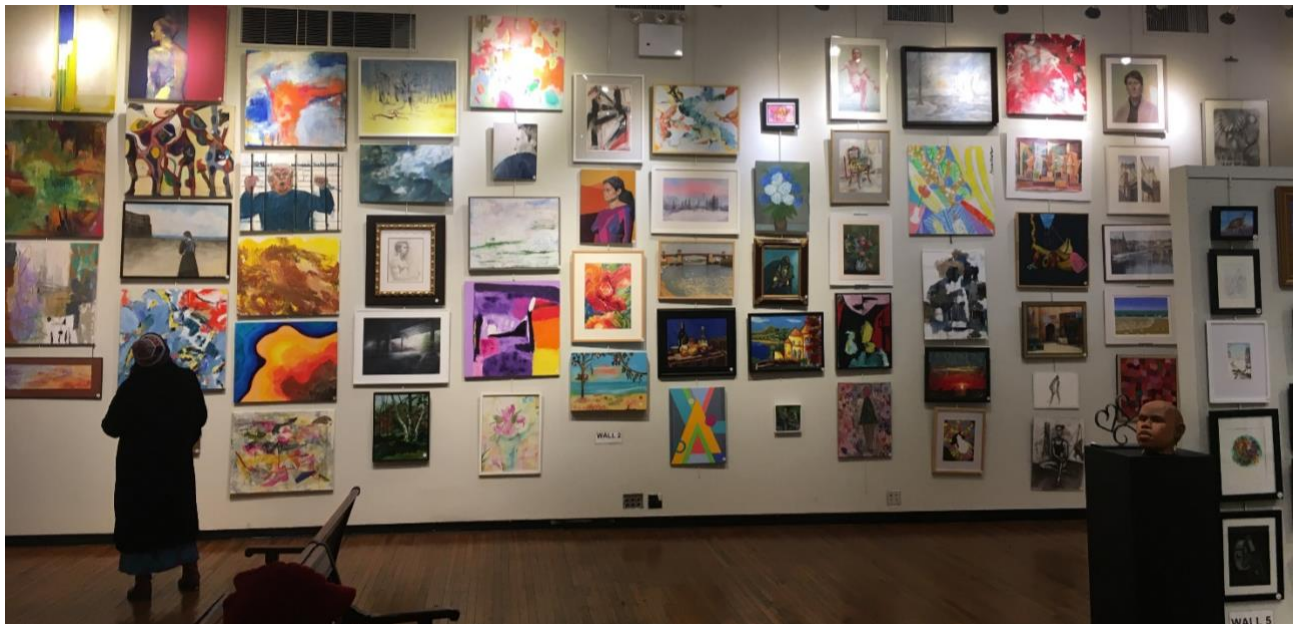

(New York, NY): The Art Students League of New York is pleased to announce the return of its Holiday Art Sale, December 14–24, 2021, featuring works for sale by League artists. The exhibition and annual sale is hosted at the League’s Phyllis Harriman Mason Gallery at 215 West 57th Street and is free and open to the public to browse available works and take home a piece of The League. All purchases directly support emerging artists and help The League continue to offer accessible, affordable, high-quality arts education and instruction.

The annual sale is a rare opportunity to purchase works by beloved League artists at a variety of prices. More than 500 original works of art including paintings, prints, and sculptures will be on rotating display. Prices start at \$50 and will not exceed \$1,500.

Because of restrictions due to Covid-19, the gallery will be limited to 30 people at a time, and all visitors must show proof of vaccination along with photo ID.

As part of the League’s holiday celebration, The League’s Exhibition Outreach program will host a **free and public holiday party on Thursday, December 16 from 4pm-6pm at One Brooklyn Bridge Park**, home to the program’s current group exhibition *Fire and Ice*. The exhibition includes a selection of League student artworks—many of which are also for sale—curated by Alexandra Rutsch Brock. Come celebrate the work of League artists at One Brooklyn Bridge Park and leave with artwork to share with friends and family.
